



SAILING AGREEMENT (SA) 2026

This sailing agreement (SA) shall be completed and signed by the person in charge before sailing a J/70 boat provided by the Swiss Sailing League Association (SSLA). The agreement is valid from the date of completion until December 31, 2026.

When participating in the Swiss Sailing League event or camp listed and organised by the Swiss Sailing League Association in 2025, and utilising the provided J/70 boats, we hereby declare that registered crew members are competent sailors and physically fit to sail under the prevailing conditions.

We agree that the person in charge at the event and camp is responsible for the safety of the boat and the crew, both afloat and ashore. This responsibility remains paramount, regardless of any specifications outlined in the Notice of Race (NoR), Sailing Instructions (SI), or elsewhere. Furthermore, we agree that the crew will maintain the boat in a clean and tidy condition and will make every effort to fulfil the requirements outlined in various documents, such as boat handling instructions

In regard to damage, breakage, or loss of equipment, the club agrees to adhere to the following provisions:

- a) The Swiss Sailing League Association (SSLA) waives the requirement for a CHF 1'000.00 cash damage deposit for the event or camp. Instead, the club, on behalf of the person in charge, declares to provide financial compensation of up to CHF 1'000.00 for any single incident (including damages, equipment losses, and repairs).
- b) Losses, breakdowns, and repairs of equipment shall be compensated according to the attached list of "Damage/Loss Charges."
- c) SSLA will maintain a damage account for each club and event.
- d) The club assures SSLA that it will settle, without objection, any costs incurred for damage, loss, or repair of equipment at the event/camp, based on the damage account, within the specified payment period after receiving an invoice from SSLA.
- e) Any damage, breakage, or loss of equipment must be reported to the designated person (the boatman) at the event/camp, whether it concerns the boat the team is sailing or another boat of which the team becomes aware.
- f) If the damage, breakage, or loss of equipment is determined to be the team's fault, SSLA may debit the club's damage account for up to the maximum payable sum of CHF 1'000.00 for that incident. The basis for this determination is the signed "Damage Report."
- g) If the damage, breakage, or loss of equipment arises from an incident involving two or more boats where responsibility cannot be clearly assigned, SSLA may debit the club's damage account for up to the maximum payable sum of CHF 1'000.00, divided equally between all parties involved in the incident. The basis for this determination is the signed "Damage Report."
- h) If the damage, breakage, or loss of equipment occurs during the event but a directly responsible party cannot be identified, SSLA may debit the club's damage account for up to the maximum payable sum of CHF 1'000.00, divided equally between all competing clubs in the event/camp.
